There is much information that needs to be gathered and prepared when applying for the Aid & Attendance Improved Pension. We have compiled a list of the documents you will need to get started.

Discharge/Separation Papers (DD-214). If you need to request military records, you can either fill out Standard Form 180 or visit our site and click the "request military records" link.
Surviving Spouses ONLY: Copy of Marriage Certificate and all marital information AND Copy of Death Certificate
Copy of current Social Security Award Letter (the letter that Social Security sends at the beginning of the year stating what your monthly amount will be for the following year).
Net Worth information, including bank accounts, CDs, Trusts, Stocks, Bonds, Annuities, etc.
Proof of all income from pensions, retirement, interest income from investments, annuities, etc.
If you are a court-appointed guardian of the veteran or surviving spouse, a certified copy of the court order of the appointment is required.
Proof of insurance premiums, medications, medical bills or any other medical expenses that ar not reimbursed by insurance, Medicare, or Medicaid.
Physician statement that includes current diagnosis, medical status, prognosis, name and address, ability to care for self, ability to travel unattended, etc.
Employment history (does not apply if you are over 65) and a list of all doctors and hospitals visited in the last year.
